

Why EGTC-GO?

The EGTC-GO was established in 2009 by the three crossborder municipalities Gorizia, Nova Gorica, Šempeter Vrtojba aiming at building up a "common home" to share strategies, ideas, projects, and to find answers to concrete problems.

After decades of divisions the EGTC brings back the three cities to the unit and give them the opportunity to work together for common goals.

The EGTC-GO is the tool to overcome the bureaucratic and administrative obstacles that hinder the implementation of joint projects in the crossborder areas. The EGTC instrument, strongly promoted by the European Union, offers a concrete response to the common needs of the three cities which will have the opportunity to work together as one entity.

The EGTC-GO therefore offers the opportunity to share those services for citizens that can be better achieved at cross-border level, ensuring the strategic and operational coordination between the three cities.

Areas of actions

The EGTC-GO is a self fundend structure and operates through technical committees, territoral group of experts which have the task of giving voice to the needs expressed by citizens and to tranform them into concrete proposals.

The EGCT aims to share some essential services (such as health services), strengthen networks of people, organizations and services in the metropolitan area, protect and enhance the area, promote initiatives to strengthen the common identity and cultural heritage, develop plans for local development both from the urban point of view that about the use and management of resources.



The EGTC-GO comprises three municipalities: Gorizia (Italy), Nova Gorica and Šempeter Vrtojba (Slovenia) and it is registered with legal personality under Italian law. The whole area of the EGTC covers a territory of 365 km² with 73,000 inhabitants.
